Vilkår:

TT gennemgår en test udarbejdet af Forsvarets Sprogtestcenter (FSTC) ved Forsvarsakademiets Institut for Sprog og Kultur (se nedenfor).

Kriterier:

Resultatet er tilfredsstillende såfremt TT består testen i alle fire færdighedsområder.

Beskrivelse af FSTC's test for SLP 2222.

Testens formål

Testen har til formål at fastslå TT's kommunikative færdighed i en række forskellige situationer, herunder:

- At lytte
- Testtageren skal demonstrere færdighed svarende til niveau 2.
- besidde et ordforråd, som er passende for enkle samværssituationer og rutineprægede job inden for en velkendt emnekreds.

 - kunne forstå konkrete oplysninger i beskrivende og fortællende udsagn om almindeligt kendte emneområder.

- besidde et ordforråd, som er passende for enkle samværsituationer og rutineprægede job som at give instruktioner og diskutere projekter inden for en velkendt emnekreds.
 - kunne beskrive, sammenligne og fortælle om kendte genstande og situationer i både fortid, nutid og fremtid.
 - beherske grammatik og udtale i en sådan grad, at meningen udtrykkes korrekt i enkle sætninger. (Det kan accepteres at TT søger efter ord og taler med tydelig accent, blot dette ikke hindrer forståelsen af det sagte.)
- At læse Testtageren skal demonstrere færdighed svarende til niveau 2
- forstå autentiske tekster om velkendte emner affattet på et rimelig enkelt sprog
 - kunne forstå den generelle mening i tekster der er skrevet med henblik på den almindelige læser
 - forstå hovedtrækkene i selv mere vanskelige tekster inden for TT's eget professionelle område
- At skrive Testtageren skal demonstrere færdighed svarende til niveau 2
- kunne affatte meddelelser af begrænset og rutinemæssigt omfang
 - beskrive personer og steder og fortælle om velkendte situationer i nutid, fortid og fremtid
 - have kendskab til principperne i skriftsproget, således at der kan skrives i enkle men sammenhængende afsnit (Overtrædelser af stil- og retskrivningsregler kan accepteres i noget omfang.)

Testens form

Den består af fire særskilte komponenter: lytte-, tale-, læse- og skriveprøver. Lytte- læse- og skriveprøverne gennemføres i et fælles lokale. Taleprøven gennemføres individuelt som en samtale med to testere og optages som lydfil.

The Wild West Today.

In the the Sonoran Desert, with the Mexican border just a few miles to the south and the thermometer frequently north of 110 degrees, there are many reasons a biologist might slam on the brakes of his four-wheel-drive and hiss a four-letter word into the summer sky.

Geopolitical reasons. Military reasons. Life-and-death animal reasons and life-and-death human reasons. A substantial portion of the coyotes in this territory, as John Morgart of the Cabeza Prieta National Wildlife Refuge sometimes reminds newcomers, probably have tasted human flesh.

"It's a very dangerous place," Morgart says.

Between Oct. 1, 2002, and mid-August 2003, more than 120 undocumented immigrants were found dead in this vast dry stretch between Yuma and Tucson. Their numbers have been growing for the last few years as California has tightened its border security, thereby redirecting traffic.

Besides the bodies found near the refuge's 56 miles of shared border with Mexico, U.S. Fish and Wildlife rangers yearly find dozens of stranded cars and tons of clothing and emptied jugs cast off by thousands of desperate itinerants who do get through

While 38 million Chinese were starving to death during 1958-61, much of the grain they produced was being shipped to the Soviet Union, where it accounted for two-thirds of all food imports. It was a weapons-technology-for-food program, a demonic bargain to make China a military superpower even at the cost of its own citizens' lives. "Half of China may well have to die," Mao said of this deal to his inner circle in 1958, according to Party documents. China's acquisition of the atom bomb, the authors calculate, "caused 100 times as many deaths as the ones dropped by the U.S. on Japan."

Bomb-laden Harrier jet crashes into neighborhood

YUMA, Arizona (AP) -- A Marine Harrier jet carrying four 500-pound bombs crashed Wednesday in a residential neighborhood, forcing the evacuation of 1,300 people.

The jet was coming in for a landing at Marine Corps Air Station-Yuma when it crashed in the backyard of a home about a mile from the base, said Marine Cpl. Michael Nease. It was also carrying 300 rounds of 25 mm cannon ammunition, he said.

The Marines were investigating the accident but had not determined a cause.

Nease said two homes near the crash site sustained some structural damage after the aircraft burst into flames. A one-mile radius around the crash was evacuated while a military explosives disposal team dismantled the bombs so they could be removed.

About 1,300 people were being evacuated, including a trailer park that is less than a block from the crash site, said Betty Conner, a training consultant for the Red Cross. A shelter was set up at a nearby middle school.

Nease said the pilot, based out of Yuma, was returning from a training mission. The pilot was the only person on board and was taken to the hospital. His injuries appeared not to be life-threatening. No one else was taken to the hospital as a result of the crash, a hospital spokeswoman said.

The AV-8B Harrier is a light attack aircraft that can take off and land vertically like a helicopter. Yuma is about 185 miles southwest of Phoenix near the Mexican border.
