Vilkår:

TT gennemgår en test udarbejdet af Forsvarets Sprogtestcenter (FSTC) ved Forsvarsakademiets Institut for Sprog og Kultur (se nedenfor).

Kriterier:

Resultatet er tilfredsstillende såfremt TT består testen i alle fire færdighedsområder.

Beskrivelse af FSTC's test for SLP 3333.

Testens formål

Testen har til formål at fastslå TT's kommunikative færdigheder i en række forskellige situationer, som følger:

- At lytte
- Testtageren skal demonstrere færdighed svarende til niveau 3.
- besidde et ordforråd som er passende for samtaler ved det daglige samarbejde og socialt samvær, såvel som for diskussioner af faglig art inden for kendt område.
 - være i stand til at opfatte en talt sætnings indhold korrekt (uanset medie). Dog forstås ikke alt i meget hurtig tale eller alle udtryk af regional eller dialektpræget karakter.

- kunne opfatte og forstå forskelle i stil, såsom humor og sproglige spidsfindigheder.

- At tale Testtageren skal demonstrere færdighed svarende til niveau 3.
- besidde ordforråd, som er passende for alle samværssituationer og for professionelle diskussioner inden for et velkendt område
 - kunne klare ukendte og komplicerede situationer og deltage i samtaler om emner som økonomi, kultur, videnskab og selvfølgelig TT's eget faglige område.
 - beherske grammatik og udtale således, at flydende samtale ikke hindres. Det accepteres, at TT ikke mestrer alle kulturelle referencer eller alle nuancer i særlige udtryk, og at der tales med tydelig accent, hvis dette ikke skaber problemer for samtalens flydende forløb.
- At læse Testtageren skal demonstrere færdighed svarende til niveau 3.
- forstå standardtekster og desuden stof af teknisk art inden for et kendt, fagligt område.
 - kunne forstå tekster skrevet til den veluddannede læser inden for områder, såsom økonomi, kultur og videnskab. Det kan accepteres, at usædvanligt komplekse tekster eller tekster, der bruger mange kulturspecifikke referencer, ikke forstås fuldstændigt.
- At skrive Testtageren skal demonstrere færdighed svarende til niveau 3.
- kunne affatte både formelle og uformelle dokumenter.
 - kunne skrive argumenterende prosa med analyser, hypoteser og udførlige forklaringer inden for et bredt spektrum af emner. Det kan accepteres at det fremmede præg ses i teksten, men meningen bør klart fremstå.
 - have en sådan kontrol over struktur og ordforråd, at budskabet klart videregives, selvom der kan forekomme fejl.

Testens form

Testen består af fire særskilte komponenter: lytte-, tale-, læse- og skriveprøver. Lytte- læse- og skriveprøverne gennemføres i et fælles lokale. Taleprøven gennemføres individuelt som en samtale med to testere og optages som lydfil.

Eksempel på multiple choice test

Improper conduct

In the area of personal relationships, the overriding operational imperative to sustain team cohesion and to maintain trust and loyalty between commanders and those they command imposes a need for standards of social behaviour which are more demanding than those required by society at large. Such demands are equally necessary during peacetime and on operations. Examples of behaviour which can undermine such trust and cohesion, and therefore damage the morale or discipline of a unit (and hence its operational effectiveness) include: unwelcome sexual attention in the form of physical or verbal conduct; over-familiarity with the spouses or partners of other Service personnel; displays of affection which might cause offence to others; behaviour which damages or hazards the marriage or personal relationships of Service personnel or civilian colleagues within the wider defence community; and taking sexual advantage of subordinates. It is important to acknowledge in the tightly knit military community a need for mutual respect and a requirement to avoid conduct which offends others. Each case will be judged on its merits.

Eksempel på udfyldningsopgave:

Looking at Eastern Europe on the eve of the fall of the Berlin Wall, said Emanuele Ottolenghi, a lecturer on the Middle East at Oxford, "we could have predicted which countries would have an easy transition to democracy and which ones not." Countries like Poland, Hungary, the Czech Republic and the Baltic states, which had a history of liberal institutions and free markets that had been suppressed by communism, quickly flourished. Others farther east, which did not have such institutions in their past and were starting from scratch - Bulgaria, Romania and the former Soviet republics - have struggled since the fall of the wall.

The same will be true in the Middle East, where democracy will not just spring up because autocrats fall down. It will arise only if these countries develop, among other things, export-oriented private sectors, which can be the foundation for a vibrant middle class that is not dependent upon the state for contracts and has a vital interest in an open economy, a free press and its own political parties. The development of such a private sector was crucial in democratizing Taiwan and South Korea.

Sony issues writ in battle with retailers over parallel imports

THE battle between Sony and British independent retailers that sell its handheld PlayStation portable game console (PSP) before its official release has reached the High Court with the Japanese group issuing a writ against at least one retailer yesterday.

Sony is engaged in legal action against ElectricBirdland, an internet retailer based in Nottingham, after the retailer's founder and sole employee, Dan Morelle, defied a demand by the Japanese group to stop selling PSPs imported from the Far East.

The PSP, which plays video games, music and films, is already a big seller in Japan and the United States, but supply shortages forced Sony to delay its European launch until September.

Retailers such as ElectricBirdland filled the gap by importing PSPs from Japan and America and selling them in Britain. The so-called parallel imports have been sold since the beginning of the year.

Sony says that the internet retailers are infringing its copyright and that the sale of imported PSPs is illegal.
